

## ***Symptoms that might occur with pain***

PAIN	COMMON SYMPTOMS
Headache	Severe pain affecting one or both sides of the head. Nausea, vomiting, hypersensitivity to light.
Period	Cramping pains, accompanied by nausea and/or vomiting
Dental	Pains in the mouth, under the chin, in the head, swelling, redness, bleeding
Bones, joints and muscles	Inflammation and pain of affected joint, reduced movement, Flu-like symptoms (fever, chills, sore throat, fatigue, headache, cough)
Indigestion	Pain in the stomach area, nausea or vomiting
Colds	Runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, cough, sinus congestion, watery eyes, mild muscular aches or headache, mild tiredness
Cough	<i>Productive</i> : a person feels that there are coughing something up ( sputum, phlegm, mucus)  <i>Non-productive</i> : often felt as a tickle in the back of the throat
Bruising	Painful brightly coloured marks on the skin
