

TEACHER'S NOTES

UNIT 1

Ask students to look for the name of the countries that appear in Catalan in English. They translate them and then situate them on the map provided. Afterwards, they write their names in English according to the continent they belong to, with the circles provided. This can be done in pairs or individually.
