

The second world war and the holocaust



Objectius

1. Identify the causes and consequences of war.
2. Recognize and identify the main characteristics of the Second World War.
3. Work in collaborative groups.
4. Participate in activities that require critical thinking.

Descripció de la proposta

This proposal presents the topic of the Second World War and the Holocaust; furthermore, it teaches students the causes as well as the consequences that take place as a result of a war.

Aspectes didàctics i metodològics

This proposal starts with the teacher presenting to students a comic book called “Maus” in which they will learn everything about the Holocaust; this way the students will get motivated about learning why it happened and when. This activity is followed by a questionnaire.

As a second activity, the teacher will show the children how to use an application of 3D reality, in which they can play in the setting of WW2 (World War 2).

Session 3 presents an activity where the students have to watch a video about Hitler's dictatorship, followed by an explanation done in small groups. Sessions 4 and 5 are devoted to team work for students to create a poster and video about the subject, in small groups, and present it in front of the class.
