SCENE 1: (IN THE PALACE)

SONG:

Queen: Harold, you are a prince. You can only marry a REAL princess.

Harold: I know, I know.



SCENE 2:

Queen: Maybe we can invite princesses to our party.
Guards: Yes, real princesses.
Harold: Oh yes! I will do it.
Queen: No, no. Only I know what real princesses are like.
Harold: They are beautiful!
Guards: yes, they are beautiful!
Queen: Wrong! They are beautiful, clever, sensitive and sweet.
Guards: Yes, they are beautiful, clever, sensitive and sweet.
Harold: I can find a REAL princess.
Queen: If you find a REAL princess, you can marry her.
Guards: A REAL PRINCESS!
Harold: Ok Mum!

SCENE 3:

King: Where is Harold?
EVERYONE: WHERE IS HAROLD? (X 3 times)
Queen: He is looking for a real princess to marry.
EVERYONE: A REAL PRINCESS x 3
King: He will never find one....
Queen: No, he will never find a real princess.
Narrator 1: Harold is writing letters.

EVERYONE: (Chant)

HAROLD IS WRITING, WRITING, WRITING,

HAROLD IS WRITING ALL DAY LONG

HAROLD IS WRITING, WRITING, WRITING

HAROLD IS WRITING ALL NIGHT LONG



Everyone: Yes, to all the princesses he knows.

Everyone: Yes, to invite them to the party.

Harold: 'Dear Princess, Please come to my party on Saturday. I am looking for a real princess to marry.'

Princess Sophie: Oh look! A letter! I want to go to the party.

Princess Diana: I am invited too!

Princess Draculina: Yes, and me!

Princess Katie: Me too!

Princess Rose: Don't forget me!

Princess Carbonara: I'm going too!

All princesses: Yes! We need to find nice dresses to wear! We're going to the party!

EVERYONE: We're going to the party!

SCENE 4:

Narrator 1: The princesses need new dresses.

Narrator 2: But they can't find the shopping centre.

Princesses: Oh no! Where is the shopping centre?

Jester 1: Don't worry! We can help you. Hehehehe.

Princesses: The Jesters can help us.

Jester 2: Yes we can! Hehehe.

Jester 3: The shopping centre is opposite the park.

Princess : But where is the park?

Jester 1: Go straight on and stop at Happy Street.

Jester 2: Turn left.

Jester 3: No, no, no! You are both very silly! Turn right and then go straight on.

Jesters 1 and 2: Oh yes! Hehehehe.

Princesses: Oh, thank you! Thank you!

Princess: Now we can buy new dresses.



SCENE 5:

Narrator 1: The Jesters tricked the princesses. They are lost.

[The princesses walk around looking lost]

Princesses: No, they tricked us!

Princess Rose: We are lost!

Princess Draculina: We are going to be late to the party.

Narrator 2: Just then, the princesses see the guards walking along the street.

Guards: We can help you!

Princesses: Oh, yes please!

Guard 1 : Go straight on.

Guard 2: Turn left.

Guard 3: Go straight on.

Guard 1: Turn right.

Guard 2: The shopping centre is opposite the cinema between the restaurant and the hotel.

Princesses: Oh thank you!

Guards: You're welcome.

SCENE 5: THE PARTY

Narrator 1: It's Saturday.

Narrator 2: The Princesses Sophie and Diana arrive at the palace.

Narrator 3: They look beautiful in their dresses.

[Princesses Sophie and Diana knock on the door]

The Guards: The Princesses are here!

Queen: Hah, none of them are real princesses.

The King: I think they are. They are beautiful.



Guard 1: Here is Princess Sophie!

Princess Sophie: MMMMMM, I love crisps. I hate fruit. [Princess Sophie eats crisps]

Jesters: Hehehehe, she is not healthy!

The King: What do you think?

Prince Harold: No, she is not healthy.

Guard 2: Here is Princess Diana.

Princess Diana: I hate sport. I watch TV all day.

The King: What do you think?

Prince Harold: No, I want a princess who is fit and healthy. Sport is good.

SCENE 6:

Narrator 1: The other princesses arrive at the palace.

Guard 1: More princesses are here!

Princess Draculina, Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara: Good evening!

The King: Good evening, welcome!

The Queen: Do you like fruit?

Princess Draculina, Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara: Yes, we do!

The Queen: Do you like washing?

Princess Draculina, Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara: Yes, we do!

The Queen: Do you like sport?

Princess Draculina, Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara: Yes, we do!

Prince Harold: Wow! These must be real princesses.

The Queen: I have a plan! I need a pea!

The Jesters: Hehehe, she has a plan! She needs a pea!



SCENE 7:

Narrator 1: It's very late.

Narrator 2: The party has finished.

Narrator 3: The Princesses are very tired.

The Queen: Don't worry, you can sleep here.

Princess Draculina, Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara: Thank you!

The Queen: I have prepared a bed for you upstairs.

Princess Draculina, Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara: Thank you!

Jesters: Hehehe, there is a pea in the bed. Hehehehehe.

The Queen: Goodnight.

Princess Draculina, Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara: Goodnight.

SCENE 8:

Narrator 1: It is morning and the maids are preparing breakfast.

Queen: Where is the breakfast? Prepare the eggs, sausages and tomatoes!

Guards: It's coming!

Narrator 2: The Princesses wake up and come downstairs.

Princess Draculina: Breakfast smells lovely!

Queen: It's a special breakfast for REAL princesses!

Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara: Yes, we are REAL princesses.

The Queen: How are you?

Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara, Princess Draculina: We are fine, thank you.

The Queen: How did you sleep?

Princess Rose, Princess Carbonara, Princess Draculina: Very well. The bed was verrrrrry comfortable.

The Queen: Hahaha, I knew it! They are not real princesses.

The Guards: You must leave. You are not real princesses.



SCENE 9:

Narrator 1: It is nighttime and the Prince is very sad.

Narrator 2: He thinks he will never find a real princess.

Prince Harold: I will never find a real princess to marry.

The Queen: I told you so!

Narrator 3: There is a storm outside. It is raining a lot.

[KNOCK ON THE DOOR]

Guards: Who is it?

Real Princess: Help! Help! I am lost!

Guards: Who are you?

Real princess: I am a real princess.

Guards: Really?

Real princess: Yes!

Guards: Come in, come in!

The Queen: Hah, you are not a real princess. Look at you! You are all wet.

Real princess: I am, I am, I promise.

The Queen: You must be very tired.

Real princess: Yes, I'm very tired.

The Queen: You can sleep on the bed upstairs.

Real Princess: Oh, thank you.

SCENE 10:

Narrator 1: It is morning and the maids are preparing breakfast.

Queen: Where is the breakfast? Prepare the eggs, sausages and tomatoes!

Guards: It's coming!

Narrator 2: The Princess wakes up and goes downstairs.



Real Princess: Breakfast smells lovely!

Queen: It's a special breakfast for REAL princesses!

Real Princess: Yes, I am a REAL princess.

The Queen: Good morning! How are you?

Real Princess: I am very tired. The bed was very uncomfortable!

Guards: Look at her! She is black and blue all over!

Real Princess: Yes! What was in the bed?

Prince Harold: Yes! She felt the pea! She is a real princess.

The Queen: Wow! Yes, she is a real princess.

The King: Prince Harold will marry her!

Narrator 1: Prince Harold married the real princess...
